DEOMI RELEASES 2020 MULTICULTURAL POSTER



PATRICK AIR FORCE BASE, Fla. – The Defense Equal Opportunity Management Institute (DEOMI) proudly announces the release of the Multicultural artwork available for download from DEOMI’s public website, www.deomi.org.

The Department of Defense Multicultural poster is the fifth in a series of posters commemorating the 75th Anniversary of World War II.

The Latin phrase, “E Pluribus Unum,” which means, “Out of Many, One” symbolizes what occurred in this worldwide event. Men and women, many of them young, came from all walks of life, united forming the most powerful wartime effort that history has ever seen.

Superimposed over each of the states is a collage of over 100 photographs of men and women from all racial and ethnic groups who stepped forward to serve their country. These members represent each of the Armed Forces as well as civilian workers who served on the “Home Front,” in shipyards, airfields, industry, farming, and other professions. It took all of them, each with an important job to do, to unite for a common cause.



The 2020 Multicultural poster recognizes the totality of effort by All Americans in total victory. The multicultural concept is meant to honor and celebrate the challenges and achievements of all Americans throughout the history of the United States and their vital contributions to the American story.
