In his famous speech "*I Have A Dream*," given at the **March On Washington**, he spoke about his dream for not only his children but all children.



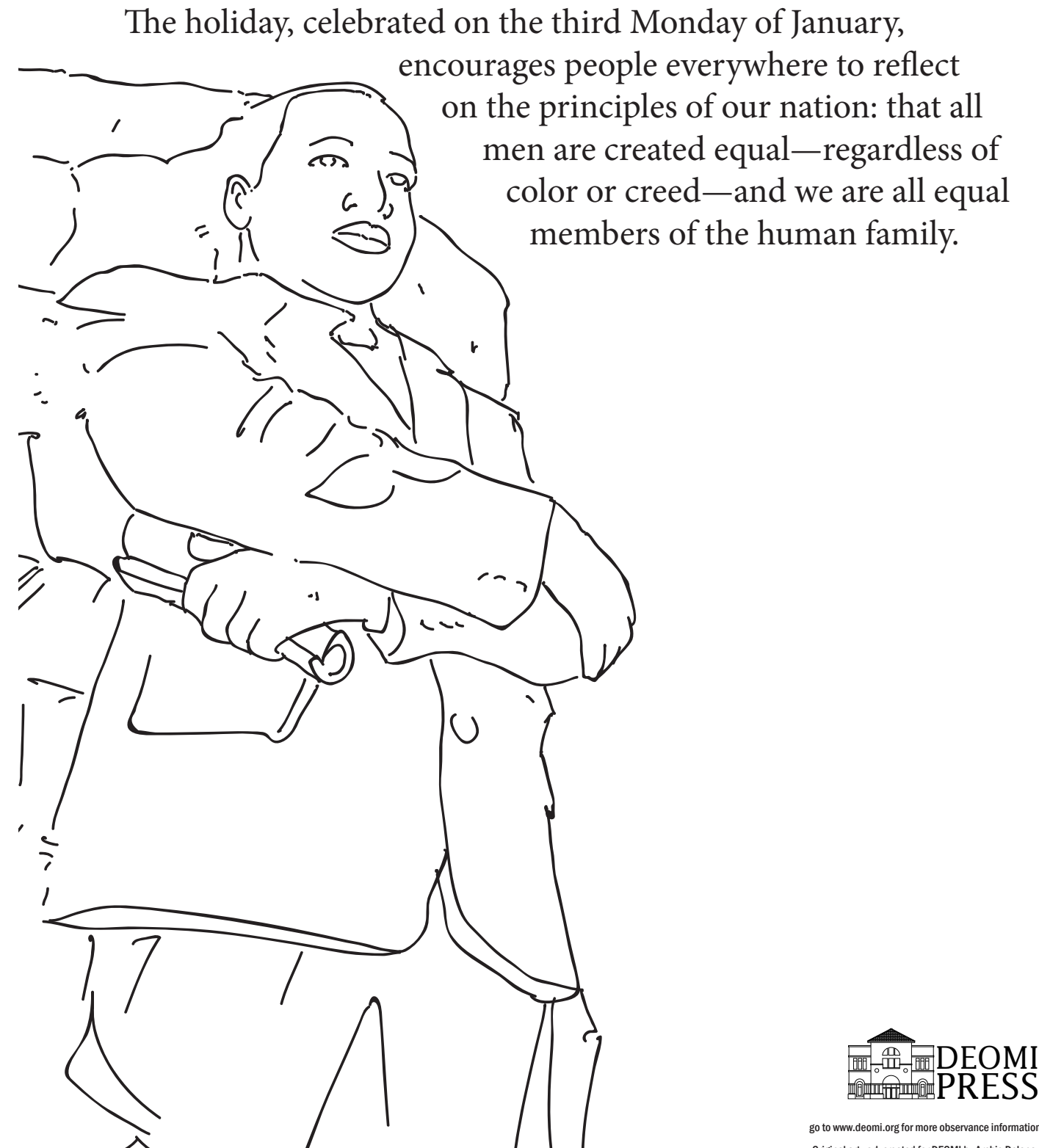
Remember! Celebrate! Act!
